Student Responsibilities

Our goal is to instill in each student a deep respect for their self and others. Students are expected to:

- * Bring their assigned book and pencil or pen to each class session;
- * Arrive on time for each class;
- * Attend each full class session;
- * Respect the authority of the catechists and other religious education personnel;
- * Respect the thoughts and feelings of other students in each class;
- * Actively take part in class discussions and activities;
- * Demonstrate respect for books, materials, desks, and personal belongings of other students who use the classrooms regularly.

Respect for themselves and others is a hallmark of our students. This is shown by the particular care student's take of their textbook, parish furniture, equipment or property.

Students may share their meeting space and desk with other students (Those who attend an alternate track and those who attend the school during the week.) It is essential that particular care be taken to make sure the meeting place is kept neat and orderly.
