LENT

REGULATIONS CONCERNING FAST

WHO: *Required of all Catholics aged 18 to 59*
Health and medicines may not permit this discipline to be followed by some. Those younger or older who can share in this discipline are encouraged to do so.

WHEN: *Ash Wednesday and Good Friday*

HOW: Fast allows for one full meal and two lesser (light) meals with no eating between these meals. This should be a full 24 hours.

REGULATIONS CONCERNING ABSTINENCE

WHO: *All Catholics aged 14 and older.*

WHEN: *Ash Wednesday, ALL Fridays of Lent including Good Friday*

HOW: *Abstinence requires that Catholics abstain from any meat on these days.*
